### What's New

The Rangeview Library District broke ground on our **Wright Farms Branch Library** on Saturday March 28, 2009. The expected completion date is Spring of 2010. The Wright Farms Branch will be the largest of Rangeview's branches and the flagship for the Library District. At 45,000 square feet, it will house the Library District's administrative staff and the new library. The design of the building along with its adjacent park, will create a seamless flow between the indoor and outdoor spaces of the building. **The Wright Farms Metropolitan District** contributed \$345,500.00 towards enhanced landscaping of the park.

There have been additional benches and a bike rack installed at our **Holly Crossing Park** and new table/bench units and a bike rack installed at our **Wright Farms Park**.
